STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to amend Section twenty-four of Chapter twenty-six of the Revised Statutes relating to Registration of Motor Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section twenty-four of chapter twenty-six of the Revised
2 Statutes is hereby amended by striking out of the thirteenth
3 and fourteenth lines of said section the words "to purchase,
4 demonstrate, sell and exchange automobiles and auto
5 trucks," and inserting in the twelfth line of said section beo fore the word 'certificate' the word 'such' so that said sec-7 tion as amended will read as follows:

'Sect. 24. Every manufacturer of or dealer in motor ve-2 hicles (automobiles or auto trucks) may instead of regis-3 tering each motor vehicle owned or controlled by him, make 4 application upon a blank provided by the Secretary of State, 5 for a general distinguishing number or mark, and said Sec-6 retary may, if satisfied with the facts stated in the applica-7 cation, grant the application and issue the applicant a certifi-8 cate of registration containing the name, place of residence 9 and address of the applicant and the general distinguishing 10 number or mark assigned to him or them and made in such 11 form as the Secretary of State may determine; and all motor 12 vehicles (automobiles and motor trucks) owned and con-13 trolled by such manufacturer or dealer shall until sold, or 14 exchanged be regarded as registered under such general dis-15 tinguishing number or mark. The annual fee for every 16 such certificate or registration shall be twenty-five dollars. 17 The Secretary of State shall furnish the manufacturer or 18 dealer with five pairs of registration number plates free of 19 cost. Extra registration plates shall be furnished to the 20 manufacturers and dealers in automobiles and auto trucks, 21 in addition to the five pairs of plates originally furnished, to 22 replace lost or mutilated plates, for seventy-five cents each.

Transportation charges or registration number plates shall 2 be paid by the receiver. On applications for registration 3 applied for by manufacturers or dealers in automobiles or 4 motor trucks, during the period between the first day of 5 October and the thirty-first day of December in any year, 6 one-half of the registration fee shall be charged.'
