IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to Designate Truant Officers as Attendance Officers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

All sections of all chapters of the Revised Statutes of 2 nineteen hundred sixteen including amendments thereto in

- 3 which the words "truant officer" occur are hereby amended 4 by inserting in place thereof the words 'attendance officer,'
- 5 and all sections in which the words "truant officers" occur
- 6 are hereby amended by inserting in place thereof the words
- 7 'attendance officers.'
