STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to Amend Section Twenty-four of Chapter Forty-five
of the Revised Statutes Relating to Violation of the Lobster
Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section twenty-four of chapter forty-five of the Revised
2 Statutes is hereby amended by striking out the whole of said
3 section and enacting in place thereof the following:

‘Sect. 24. Any certificate of the Commissioner of Sea and
2 Shore Fisheries in regard to the records of his office, shall be
3 admissible in evidence in all prosecutions under this chap-
4 ter.’
