STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to regulate the sale of milk in bottles or jars, within the Town of Eden, Hancock County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Section 1. No person, either by himself, clerk, servant,
- 2 or agent, shall sell, or offer for sale, any milk or cream, in
- 3 bottles or jars, within the Town of Eden, Hancock County,
- 4 Maine, unless the name or initials of such person, or those
- 5 of his principal, are blown in the bottle or jar, containing
- 6 the milk or cream so sold or offered.
- Sect. 2. Whoever, as principal or as clerk, servant, or 2 agent, violates the provisions of the first section hereof

3 shall forfeit the sum of ten dollars for each offence, to be 4 recovered by complaint.
