STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT relating to the Department of Agriculture.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

All moneys received by the State of Maine as penalties and
2 costs through the enforcement of laws by the State Depart-
3 ment of Agriculture and all money received by the State of
4 Maine for fees and licenses through the State Department of
5 Agriculture, and all other money received by the State of
6 Maine through the State Department of Agriculture shall be
7 kept by the Treasurer of State as a separate fund for the
8 use of the State Department of Agriculture and in addition
9 to the appropriations made for that department.
