STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to ratify the organization of Capital Park and give
additional powers to said corporation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The organization of Capital Park, a corpora-
2 tion organized under the general law, the certificate of which
3 was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the sixth
4 day of March, 1917, is hereby ratified and confirmed.

Sect. 2. Said corporation shall have all the powers and be
2 subject to all the limitations expressed in its certificate of
3 organization, and shall be exempt from the provisions of
4 Section twenty-eight of Chapter fifty-one, and of Section

5 eighteen of Chapter nine of the Revised Statutes, and shall
6 have all the benefits and immunities of charitable corpora-
7 tions organized under Chapter sixty-two of the Revised
8 Statutes.
