STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

RESOLVE in aid of navigation of various lakes, rivers and
thoroughfares in the State of Maine.

Resolved, that the sum of thirty-six hundred dollars be,
2 and hereby is, appropriated for the following purposes; to
3 wit; the placing of buoys, the erection of lights and the
4 maintenance of same in the inland waters of the State of
5 Maine as hereinafter set forth together with that part of
6 said thirty-six hundred dollars which shall be expended for
7 the years of nineteen hundred and seventeen and nineteen
8 hundred and eighteen for the purposes above enumerated in
9 each locality as hereinafter stated.

Said buoys and lights shall be placed at such points in said
2 localities as will best serve the needs of navigation thereon
3 and all said money shall be expended under the supervision
4 of the State Steamboat Inspectors and they shall be paid the
5 same as provided in section sixteen of chapter fifty nine of
6 the revised statutes of nineteen hundred and sixteen, and
7 any part of the money hereby appropriated for the placing
8 of said buoys and erection and maintenance of said lights
9 which shall be unexpended at the end of the year nineteen
10 hundred and eighteen shall revert back to the State.

In Moosehead Lake, the sum of seven hundred dollars for
2 the year nineteen hundred and seventeen and the sum of six
3 hundred dollars for the year of nineteen hundred and
4 eighteen.

In Sebago Lake, Songo river, Bay of Naples, Chutes river
2 and Long lake in Cumberland County, the sum of four
3 hundred dollars for the year of nineteen hundred and seven-
4 teen and the sum of four hundred dollars for year of nine-
5 teen hundred and eighteen.

In Rangeley Lake, Mooselucmaguntic Lake, and Cupsuptic
2 Lake, the sum of three hundred and fifty dollars for the
3 year of nineteen hundred and seventeen and the sum of
4 three hundred and fifty dollars for the year of nineteen hun-
5 dred and eighteen.

In North Twin Lake, North Twin Thoroughfare, South
2 Twin Lake, South Twin Thoroughfare, Pamedumcook
3 Lake, Pamedumcook Thoroughfare, Ambejejis Lake, and

4 Ambejejis Thoroughfare, the sum of two hundred dollars
5 for the year of nineteen hundred and seventeen and the sum
6 of two hundred dollars for the year of nineteen hundred
7 and eighteen.

In Sebec Lake, the sum of one hundred dollars for the year
2 of nineteen hundred and seventeen and the sum of one hun-
3 dred dollars for the year of nineteen hundred and eighteen.

In Lewys, Long and Big Lakes in Washington County, the
2 sum of fifty dollars for the year of nineteen hundred and
3 seventeen and the sum of fifty dollars for the year of nine-
4 teen hundred and eighteen.

In the narrows between Upper and Lower Richardson
2 Lakes, the sum of fifty dollars for the year of nineteen
3 hundred and seventeen and the sum of fifty dollars for the
4 year of nineteen hundred and eighteen.
