### STATE OF MAINE

# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to enable the chief engineer of the state highway commission to convey a certain lot or parcel of land owned by the State of Maine to the European & North American Railroad.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Whereas the state highway commission of Maine has entered into an agreement which necessitates the conveying of
a certain lot or parcel of land owned by the state of Maine
to the European & North American Railroad, therefore,
Be it enacted that the chief engineer of the state highway

2 commission is hereby empowered and authorized in the name 3 of the state of Maine to convey to the European & North 4 American Railroad a certain lot or parcel of land situated 5 on Treat & Webster island in Old Town, county of Penob-6 scot and state of Maine, being the same premises conveyed 7 to the state of Maine by Charles L. Perkins and Fannie M. 8 Perkins, his wife, on the ninth day of July, A. D. 1914, and 9 recorded in the registry of deeds, county of Penobscot, Vol. 10 873, page 191, to which deed and record reference is hereby 11 made for a more particular description of the premises 12 which the chief engineer of the state highway commission 13 is hereby authorized to convey to the European & North 14 American Railroad.
