STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to Authorize the City of Augusta to Acquire Property.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The City of Augusta shall have power to purchase, take, or otherwise acquire and hold such real and personal property, in addition to that now held, as its city council may find necessary for municipal purposes.

Sect. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
