STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT authorizing the municipal officers of the town of
Machias to close a bridge over tide-water.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Authority is hereby granted the municipal officers of the
2 town of Machias to abolish a bridge over tide-water in said
3 town leading to the old Shaw ship-yard, so-called; said
4 bridge being located on Court street, just west of the Maine
5 Central station and yard.
