STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

An Act to Amend Chapter Four Hundred and Fifty-two of the
Private and Special Laws of Eighteen Hundred and Ninety-
seven, Relating to the Trustees of the Fund for the Support
of the Episcopate of the Protestant Episcopal Church in the
Diocese of Maine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section One of Chapter Four Hundred and Fifty-two of
2 the Private and Special Laws of Eighteen Hundred and
3 Ninety-seven, relating to the Trustees of the fund for the
4 support of the Episcopate of the Protestant Episcopal

5 Church in the Diocese of Maine, is hereby amended by
6 striking out the word "two" in the fourth line of said Sec-
7 tion, and inserting in place thereof the word 'five,' so that
8 said Section as amended shall read as follows:

'Section 1. The Trustees of the Diocesan Funds in the
2 Diocese of Maine shall have power to take and hold real
3 and personal estate contributed for parochial endowments
4 or other church purposes, to the amount of Five Hundred
5 Thousand Dollars, and to manage and dispose of the same
6 in accordance with the terms of the several gifts, grants, or
7 endowments, and said trustees shall keep an account with
8 each endowment or gift comprising said fund, and report
9 their doings in managing the same and the condition thereof,
10 to the Convention of the Diocese annually.'
