STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

An Act to Authorize the Construction of a Weir in the Tide-
Waters of Little Machias Bay in the town of Cutler.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. A. A. Hodgdon of Cutler and others in the
2 County of Washington are hereby authorized to build and
3 maintain a weir for fishing purposes in front of land leased
4 by said A. A. Hodgdon, in the tide-waters of Little Machias
5 Bay in said town of Cutler; provided said weir does not
6 interfere in the navigation or rights of others.

Sect. 2. The above-mentioned weir shall be located as

2 follows, to wit: the pound of the weir to be located on the
3 easterly side of the ledge known as Marston's Ledge on the
4 westerly side of Little Machias Bay in the town of Cutler;
5 the pound of the weir to be six hundred ten feet from Mars-
6 ton's Ledge, ninety-six feet swing, and face the north-west,
7 with one wing of not more than three stakes, running west-
8 erly to Marston's Ledge.
