STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to Amend section one of Chapter Eleven of the Revised Statutes of Maine, Relating to the Collection of Taxes and the Commitment of Poll Taxes in Incorporated Places.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section one of chapter eleven of the revised statutes of
2 Maine is hereby amended by inserting in the fourth line
3 of said section, between the word "that" and the word "the"
4 the following words: 'that any town or city may provide at
5 its annual meeting that' so that said section as amended,
6 shall read as follows:

‘Section 1. Towns, at their annual meetings, may determine when the lists named in section eighty-five of chapter 3 ten shall be committed, and when their taxes shall be payable, and that interest shall be collected thereafter; provided, 5 however, that any town or city may provide at its annual 6 meeting that the poll taxes shall be due and payable on the 7 first day of May and the commitment of the lists of poll 8 tax payers shall be made to the collector prior to that date.’
