STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to amend chapter one hundred seventeen of the Revised Statutes, relating to the salary of county attorney and of assistant county attorney for Cumberland county and to provide clerk hire therefor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section thirty-seven of chapter one hundred
2 seventeen of the revised statutes is hereby amended by strik-
3 ing out the word "seventeen" in the sixth line thereof and
4 inserting in lieu thereof the word 'eighteen' and by striking
5 out the word "nine" in the twenty-first line thereof and

6 inserting in lieu thereof, the words 'one thousand' so that
7 said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 37. County attorneys of the several counties shall
2 receive annual salaries from the state treasury in monthly
3 payments on the last day of each month, as follows:

Androscoggin, twelve hundred dollars.

Aroostook, fifteen hundred dollars.

Cumberland, eighteen hundred dollars.

Franklin, five hundred dollars.

Hancock, seven hundred and fifty dollars.

Kennebec, fourteen hundred dollars.

Knox, seven hundred dollars.

Lincoln, five hundred dollars.

Oxford, nine hundred dollars.

Penobscot, fifteen hundred dollars.

Piscataquis, six hundred dollars.

Sagadahoc, six hundred dollars.

Somerset, eight hundred and fifty dollars.

Waldo, five hundred dollars.

Washington, nine hundred dollars.

York, twelve hundred dollars; and no other fees, costs or
2 emoluments shall be allowed them. The assistant county
3 attorney for the county of Cumberland, one thousand dol-
4 lars. He shall hold his office during the term of the county
5 attorney by him he is appointed, subject to removal at any
6 time by the justice of the superior court for said county.'

7 Sect. 2. Section forty-five of chapter one hundred seven-

2 teen of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding to
3 the fourth paragraph thereof, the following: 'for clerks in
4 the office of the county attorney six hundred dollars' so that
5 said paragraph as amended shall read as follows:

'Cumberland county; for clerks in the office of register of
2 deeds, two thousand seven hundred dollars; for clerks in
3 the office of register of probate, two thousand one hundred
4 dollars; for clerks in the office of clerk of courts, two thou-
5 sand two hundred dollars; for clerks in the office of the
6 recorder of the Portland municipal court, seven hundred
7 eighty dollars; for clerks in the office of county attorney,
8 six hundred dollars.'
