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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

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AN ACT to amend Revised Statutes, Chapter 117, Section 16,  
relating to the State Treasurer.

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*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Chapter one hundred seventeen, Section sixteen is hereby  
2 amended by inserting in the second line thereof between the  
3 word "thousand" and the word "dollars," the words 'five  
4 hundred' and by inserting after the word "dollars" in the  
5 second line the words 'and the said two thousand five hun-  
6 dred dollars shall be appropriated each year beginning with  
7 the year nineteen hundred seventeen and paid to the state  
8 treasurer and charged to the appropriation for his depart-

9 ment' so that said section as amended shall read as follows :

'Sect. 16. The treasurer of state shall receive an annual  
2 salary of two thousand five hundred dollars, and the said  
3 two thousand five hundred dollars shall be appropriated  
4 each year beginning with the year nineteen hundred seven-  
5 teen and paid to the state treasurer and charged to the ap-  
6 propriation for his department; he shall receive no other  
7 fee, emolument or perquisite.

The chief clerk in the office of the treasurer of state shall  
2 be designated as "Deputy Treasurer of State" and shall  
3 receive an annual salary of eighteen hundred dollars.'
