STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to amend Section eight of Chapter three hundred and twenty-five of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred ninety-seven, as amended by Chapter one hundred and fifty of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and fifteen, fixing the salary for the recorder of the Municipal Court of Waterville.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Section 1. Section eight of chapter three hundred and 2 twenty-five of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen 3 hundred and ninety-seven, as amended by chapter one hun-

4 dred and fifty of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen
5 hundred and fifteen, is hereby amended by striking out the
6 last sentence of said section and substituting in place there-
7 of the following: 'The Recorder shall receive from the
8 treasury of the County of Kennebec, in monthly payments,
9 an annual salary of four hundred dollars, which shall be
10 in full for all fees pertaining to his office,' so that said sec-
11 tion as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 8. There shall be appointed by the Governor, for
2 said Court, a recorder, who shall keep the records of said
3 court when requested so to do by the judge; and in case
4 of absence from the court room, or sickness of the judge,
5 or when the office of judge shall be vacant, the recorder
6 shall have and exercise all the powers of the judge, and
7 perform all the duties required of said judge by this act,
8 and shall be empowered to sign and issue all processes and
9 papers, and to do all acts as fully and with the same effect
10 as the judge could do were he acting in the premises; and
11 the signature of the recorder, as such, shall be sufficient evi-
12 dence of his right to act instead of the judge. The Recorder
13 shall receive from the treasury of the County of Kennebec,
14 in monthly payments, an annual salary of four hundred dol-
15 lars, which shall be in full for all fees pertaining to his office.
