STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to Provide for the Establishment of a Bureau of
Markets and to Provide for Marketing Farm Products and
Purchasing Farm Supplies.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The commissioner of agriculture is hereby authorized to
2 expend the sum of three thousand five hundred dollars an-
3 nually hereafter to study the methods and cost of marketing
4 farm products and purchasing farm supplies, by employing
5 agents and experts who shall work in conjunction with the
6 Farmers' Union of Maine, the Fruit Growers' Association,
7 and other farm organizations.
