STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to fix the salary of the clerk of courts of the county
of Lincoln.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The annual salary of the clerk of the Judicial Court of the
2 county of Lincoln shall be twelve hundred dollars instead of
3 the amount fixed by section forty of chapter one hundred
4 seventeen of the Revised Statutes of nineteen hundred six-
5 teen.
