# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to Amend Section 18 of Chapter 45 of the Revised Statutes, 1916, relating to Regulation of Lobster Industry.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section eighteen of chapter forty-five of the revised stat-

- 2 utes of nineteen hundred sixteen is hereby amended by add-
- 3 ing after the word "license" in the fourth line thereof, the
- 4 following words, 'or to persons, firms or corporations con-
- 5 ducting hotels, restaurants or boarding-houses within the
- 6 state to give away, sell or expose for sale within the state,'
- 7 so that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'The commissioner of sea and shore fisheries shall grant

2 and issue licenses to any citizen of this state, or to any per-3 son who has resided in this state for one year immediately 4 preceding the date of application for license, or to persons, 5 firms or corporations, conducting hotels, restaurants, or 6 boarding-houses, within the state, to give away, sell, or ex-7 pose for sale within the state, or to corporations or firms en-8 gaged in the lobster business located in this state or other 9 states, to catch, take, hold, buy, ship, transport, carry, give 10 away, remove, sell or expose for sale, within this state, and 11 have in his or its possession lobsters from the waters within 12 the jurisdiction of this state, in the manner, at the time and 13 subject to the regulations provided in sections seventeen to 14 thirty-four, both inclusive. Applications for licenses shall 15 be made upon special forms provided by the commissioner 16 of sea and shore fisheries, and the said commissioner shall 17 keep the clerks of the various cities, towns and plantations 18 bordering on the seashore, and other clerks who request 19 them, supplied with blank applications; said clerks shall keep 20 a supply of the same on hand and furnish them to all appli-21 cants. All applications, when filled out, shall be forwarded 22 to the office of said commissioner, together with the fees for Such licenses shall be granted to expire on the last 23 same. 24 day of November next succeeding the granting of the same, 25 unless sooner revoked, as provided in section twenty and each 26 person, firm or corporation to whom licenses shall be 27 granted, shall, for each license, pay to said commissioner the 28 sum of one dollar for the use of the state, to be forwarded 29 to the treasurer of state; which amounts shall be credited to 30 and be a part of the funds to be used for operating ex31 penses in the department of sea and shore fisheries. The 32 commissioner, in his biennial report shall state the number 33 of licenses granted, the names of the parties licensed and the 34 amount of money received therefor. He shall issue to each 35 person, firm or corporation licensed as aforesaid a certificate, 36 stating the name of the person, firm or corporation to whom 37 such license has been granted, the number of said license and 38 the date of expiration of such license.'
