STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT authorizing the selectmen of the town of Brooksville, to grant a private way over tide waters in said Brooksville.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The selectmen of the town of Brooksville are hereby authorized and empowered to locate a private way from the property of J. Howard Wilson, an inhabitant and owner of cultivated land in said town, across the tide water between the cultivated land in said township known as Nautilus Island, a part of the mainland of said Brooksville, and

7 the shore of said town opposite said Nautilus Island; said
8 way to be located over the sand bar covered by tide water
9 at high tide, thence along said shore to the right of the bar
10 several rods until it turns inland.

Said way over tide water being a part of the way said
2 J. Howard Wilson has petitioned the said municipal officers
3 of Brooksville to lay out and locate for him, to connect
4 his aforesaid property with a highway of said town of
5 Brooksville.
