STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

RESOLVE in favor of the Reformatory for Women for the construction of additional buildings and other purposes for the years nineteen hundred seventeen and nineteen hundred eighteen.

Resolved, That there be, and hereby is, appropriated

For the Reformatory for Women.

*For the erection and equipment of one or more buildings
2 for the housing of the inmates of said institution, in addi-
3 tion to those already built or under construction, for the*

4 year nineteen hundred seventeen, the sum of eighteen thou-
5 sand seven hundred and fifty (\$18,750.00) dollars, and for
6 the year nineteen hundred eighteen, the sum of sixteen
7 thousand two hundred and fifty (\$16,250.00) dollars.

For the furnishing and equipping of said buildings, for
2 the year nineteen hundred and eighteen, the sum of two
3 thousand five hundred (\$2,500.00) dollars.

Provided, that any balance of the sums above appropri-
2 ated for the year nineteen hundred seventeen which may
3 remain unexpended at the end of the year shall be avail-
4 able for expenditure during the year nineteen hundred
5 eighteen, and provided further that the governor and coun-
6 cil may, by order, upon recommendation of the trustees of
7 the said institution, authorize the use of unexpended bal-
8 ances of any of the above appropriations to meet deficiencies
9 in other appropriations for such institution.
