STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT relating to the operation of motor vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. No person operating a motor vehicle in the set-
tled parts of a city or town shall at any time open the muff-
ler cut-out nor permit such motor vehicle to make any un-
necessary noise.

Sect. 2. Any person violating the above section shall for
each offense be punished by a fine of not more than twenty
dollars.
