STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT to repeal as much of section 6 of chapter 33 of the Revised Statutes as applied to the Presumpscot River in the County of Cumberland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

That so much of Section 6 of chapter 33 of the Revised

- 2 Statutes as applied to the Presumpscot River be repealed.
- 3 That the attorney general is hereby empowered and directed
- 4 to take immediate steps to insure the construction of proper
- 5 and adequate fishways for passage of migratory fish in each
- 6 and all dams in the Presumpscot River in the County of
- 7 Cumberland.
