#### STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT to amend section eighty-two of chapter one hundred fifteen of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter one hundred thirty-six of the Laws of Maine for 1917, Relative to Support of Debtors in Jail.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section eighty-two of chapter one hundred fifteen of the

- 2 Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter one hundred thirty-
- 3 six of the laws of Maine for 1917, is hereby amended by
- 4 striking out the words "Not exceeding fifty cents a day," and
- 5 inserting in place thereof the words 'Not exceeding seventy-

6 five cents a day,' so that said section as amended shall read 7 as follows:

'Sect. 82. In case of dispute about the price of such sup-2 port, the county commissioners may determine it, not ex-3 ceeding seventy-five cents a day.'
