STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT to Amend Section Thirty-eight of Chapter One Hundred Seventeen of the Revised Statutes, as Amended by Chapters One Hundred Sixty-seven, One Hundred Fifty-two, and Two Hundred Ninety-two of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred Seventeen, Increasing the Salary of the Judge of Probate of Hancock County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section thirty-eight of chapter one hundred seventeen of
2 the revised statutes, as amended by chapters one hundred
3 sixty-seven, one hundred fifty-two, and two hundred ninety-
4 two of the public laws of nineteen hundred seventeen, is
5 hereby amended by striking out after the word "Hancock."

6 in the ninth line thereof, the word “eleven” and inserting in
7 place thereof the word ‘sixteen’ so that said section, as
8 amended, shall read as follows:

‘Judges of probate in the several counties shall receive
2 annual salaries from the treasurers of the counties in equal
3 monthly payments on the last day of each month, as fol-
4 lows:

- 5 Androscoggin, sixteen hundred dollars;
- 6 Aroostook, twelve hundred dollars;
- 7 Cumberland, three thousand dollars;
- 8 Franklin, six hundred dollars;
- 9 Hancock, sixteen hundred dollars;
- 10 Kennebec, seventeen hundred dollars;
- 11 Knox, seven hundred dollars;
- 12 Lincoln, five hundred dollars;
- 13 Oxford, one thousand dollars;
- 14 Penobscot, eighteen hundred dollars;
- 15 Piscataquis, six hundred dollars;
- 16 Sagadahoc, eight hundred dollars;
- 17 Somerset, eight hundred dollars;
- 18 Waldo, seven hundred dollars;
- 19 Washington, eight hundred dollars;
- 20 York, sixteen hundred dollars;

21 and the fees to which they are entitled by law, except the
22 fee provided in section forty-nine of chapter one hundred
23 forty-five, shall be taxed and collected and paid over by
24 the registers of probate to the county treasurers for the
25 use of their counties.’
