STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT authorizing the Oxford Electric Company to discontinue the operation of its road and to dispose of its franchise and property.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The Oxford Electric Company, a corporation organized
2 under the general laws of the State of Maine, is hereby
3 authorized, with the consent of the Public Utilities Commis-
4 sion of the State of Maine, to discontinue the operation of
5 its electric street railroad extending from Pleasant street in
6 Norway Village to a point opposite Hotel Andrews in Market
7 Square in South Paris, and to sell or otherwise dispose of its

8 franchise, property and equipment used in connection with
9 the operation of said road.
