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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND  
NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

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AN ACT to protect the lobsters within three miles of Matinicus  
and Criehaven Plantations.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to set any lobster trap be-  
2 tween the fifteenth day of July and the fifteenth day of  
3 September of each year within three miles of Matinicus and  
4 Criehaven Plantations.

Sect. 2. Each person violating the provisions of the fore-  
2 going section shall be fined ten dollars for each lobster trap  
3 set contrary to the provisions of said section, and all traps,  
4 warps and buoys set contrary to the provisions of said  
5 section shall be forfeited.
