IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT to Amend Paragraph Fifteen, Section Forty-five of Chapter One Hundred and Seventeen of the Revised Statutes, Relative to Clerk Hire in the Office of Register of Probate in Waldo County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section forty-five of chapter one hundred and seventeen

2 of the revised statutes, paragraph fifteen, is hereby amended

3 by striking out the words "one hundred dollars" in the

4 second and third lines thereof, and inserting after the word

5 "probate" in the second line thereof the words 'four hun
6 dred dollars,' so that said paragraph as amended shall read

'Waldo county; for clerks in the office of register of deeds, 2 seven hundred and eighty dollars; for clerks in the office 3 of register of probate four hundred dollars; for clerks in 4 the office of clerk of courts five hundred dollars.'
