STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

RESOLVE, authorizing the State Land Agent to sell certain lots in the town of St. Agatha in the County of Aroostook.

Resolved: that the land agent of the state of Maine be and 2 he hereby is authorized to sell for cash lots numbered ninety-3 four, ninety-five, ninety-six, ninety-seven, ninety-eight, 4 ninety-nine, one hundred, one hundred and one, one hundred 5 and two, one hundred and three, one hundred and four, one 6 hundred and five, one hundred and six, one hundred and 7 seven, one hundred and eight, one hundred and ten, in town-8 ship number eighteen, range five, west of the east line of the 9 state, if he deem it advisable, for such price per acre, and 10 on such terms of payment as he may deem advantageous.
