STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT to Authorize the Erection of a Weir in the Waters of Cobscook Bay in the Town of Lubec.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Frank Hallett of Lubec in the county of Wash-

- 2 ington is hereby authorized to build and maintain a weir
- 3 for fishing purposes in front of land owned by him in the
- 4 tide waters of Cobscook bay in said Lubec; provided said
- 5 weir does not interfere with navigation or the right of 6 others.
 - Sect. 2. The above mentioned weir shall be located as
- 2 follows and within the following described boundaries:
- 3 Beginning at a point of land known as Armstrong's Point,

4 about one thousand feet southerly of the boundary line of 5 land of Frank Hallett and Edward Wilson, and extending 6 easterly one hundred and seventy-five feet below mean low 7 water mark; thence northerly two hundred and twenty-five 8 feet, thence westerly to the shore of the land of Frank Halgett, with the right to erect such structures on the shore 10 between high and low water mark as would be necessary

11 to the maintenance of such weir.
