STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT to amend section one hundred twenty-two of chapter fifty-three of the Revised Statutes of Maine, relating to Life Insurance Agents and Brokers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Relating to the appointment of non-resident agents and 2 brokers. Section 122 of chapter 53 of the revised statutes 3 is hereby amended by inserting after the word "agents" in 4 the fourth line of said section the following: 'Or to any 5 resident of another state having similar reciprocal relations 6 to do a life business in this state who is under contract with 7 any life insurance company, and who shall first make a con-

8 tract with the general agent or manager of said company in 9 this state.'

'All business done in this state by agents and brokers resid-2 ing out of the state must be done and first premiums pay-3 ments, on account of said business, made through the Maine 4 agency of the company represented by the agent or broker.'
