STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT to Extend the Authority of the American Thread Company to Erect a Bridge Across Sebec River in the Town of Milo.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The rights, powers and privileges which were granted to

- 2 the American Thread Company by chapter 175, private and
- 3 Special Laws 1917, to erect and maintain a bridge across
- 4 Sebec river in the town of Milo are hereby extended for a
- 5 period of two years from the time this act takes effect.
