STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT to Extend the Charter of the Quebec Extension Railway Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section I. Charter extended two years. The rights, pow-*2* ers and privileges of the Quebec Extension Railway Com-*3* pany, which were granted by chapter forty-one of the pri-*4* vate and special laws of nineteen hundred and thirteen, and *5* extended by chapter fifty-six of the private and special laws *6* of nineteen hundred and fifteen, and extended by chapter *7* fifteen of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred *8* and seventeen, are hereby continued in force and extended *9* for two years from the time this act goes into effect, and

10 all the rights, powers, privileges and franchises which were
11 granted, or have been acquired by virtue of said act, may,
12 and shall be, exercised in the same manner and for the same
13 purpose as provided in said chapter forty-one.

Sect. 2. Nothing herein contained is intended to repeal 2 or shall be construed as repealing the whole or any part of 3 any existing statute, and all the rights and duties herein 4 mentioned shall be exercised and performed in accordance 5 with all the applicable provisions of chapter fifty-five of 6 the revised statutes, and acts amendatory thereof or addi-7 tional thereto.
