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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND  
NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

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AN ACT to Amend Section Forty-eight of Chapter Six of the Revised Statutes, Relating to the Enrollment of Voters at Political Caucuses.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section forty-eight of chapter six of the revised statutes 2 is hereby amended by striking out after the word "apply" 3 in the second line of said section the following words: "to 4 towns of less than two thousand inhabitants, nor," so that 5 said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 48. The provisions of the eleven preceding sections 2 shall not apply to cities of more than thirty-five thousand 3 inhabitants, nor to cities wherein the calling and holding

4 of caucuses, is regulated by special law until such special
