STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

RESOLVE, Making an Appropriation for Co-operative Agricultural Work Between the College of Agriculture of the University of Maine and the United States Department of Agriculture.

Resolved, That there be, and hereby is, appropriated to 2 be paid to the University of Maine for co-operative agri-3 cultural work between its College of Agriculture and the 4 United States Department of Agriculture, as such work is 5 defined in an Act of the Congress of the United States, ap-6 proved May eighth, nineteen hundred fourteen, entitled "An 7 act to provide for co-operative agricultural work between 8 the agricultural colleges in the several states receiving the

9 benefits of an Act of Congress, approved July second, eight10 een hundred sixty-two, and acts supplementary thereto, and
11 the United States Department of Agriculture," for the fiscal
12 year to begin July first, nineteen hundred nineteen, the sum
13 of nineteen thousand fifteen dollars and eighty-eight cents,
14 and for the fiscal year beginning July first, nineteen hun15 dred twenty, the sum of twenty-two thousand six hundred
16 seventy-two dollars and seventy-eight cents.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

In nineteen hundred fifteen the Legislature of the State of Maine assented to the provisions and requirements of an Act of the Congress of the United States, approved May eighth, nineteen hundred fourteen, entitled "An act to provide for cooperative agricultural work between the agricultural colleges in the several states receiving the benefits of an Act of Congress, approved July second, eighteen hundred sixty-two, and acts supplementary thereto, and the United States Department of Agriculture." In order to conform to the aforesaid assent this appropriation is requisite.
