Resolved, That the sum of one hundred and eighty-three
2 dollars (\$183) be and hereby is appropriated to be paid to
3 Mitchell M. Nicolar, representative of the Penobscot tribe
4 of Indians, for attendance and mileage at session of the
5 seventy-ninth legislature.
