STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT to Permit the Town of Southport to Obtain a Supply
of Pure Water.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The rights, powers and privileges of the town of Southport
2 which were granted by chapter 129 of the Private and Spe-
3 cial Laws of nineteen hundred and fifteen, are hereby ex-
4 tended for a period of two years from the time this act shall
5 take effect and the town of Southport shall have all the
6 rights, powers and privileges that were granted by said
7 chapter 129 to be exercised in the same manner and for the
8 purposes therein specified.
