STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT Relative to the Tenure of Office of County Treasurers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section 3 of chapter 13 of the revised statutes is hereby 2 amended by striking out the word "two" in the fourth line 3 of said section and inserting in place thereof the word 4 'four,' so that said section as amended, shall read as fol-5 lows:

'Sect. 3. BOND AND TENURE OF OFFICE. R. S. c. 2 12, §3. The person so elected and accepting shall give bond 3 to the county for the faithful discharge of his duties in 4 such sum as the commissioners order, and with such sure-5 ties as they approve in writing thereon, and shall hold his

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6 office for four years from the first day of the next January, 7 and until another is chosen and qualified in his place.
