STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT Relative to the Quality of Coal Sold at Retail.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section I. The Public Utilities Commission is hereby authorized and directed to investigate the quality of anthracite coal sold at retail in this state and to prescribe a standard for the same. The standard so established shall be promulgated by circulars sent to all coal dealers in the state, so far as they can be ascertained, and by publication in the newspapers or otherwise as the commission may deem best. The said standard shall be determined and promulgated as aforesaid on or before the fifteenth day of July in the current year, and it shall be unlawful for any person to sell at retail in this state any anthracite coal which falls

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12 below the standard so established. Violation of the pro13 visions of this section shall be punished by a fine of not
14 less than five nor more than five hundred dollars for each
15 offence.

Sect. 2. It shall be the duty of the attorney-general and 2 of the several county attorneys to investigate any alleged 3 case of the violation of the standard established hereunder, 4 and to prosecute any persons, firms or corporations guilty 5 of such violation.

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
