STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT to Provide for Retiring and Pensioning Employees of the State of Maine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The superintendent and board of trustees of

- 2 any state institution and the head of any state department
- 3 may recommend the retirement from active service and the
- 4 placing upon a pension roll, any employee who has been
- 5 employed in any state institution or department of this
- 6 state, with a good record for the term of twenty-five con-
- 7 secutive years, or more, and such employee, subject to the
- 8 approval of the Governor and Council, shall be so retired
- 9 and pensioned.

- Sect. 2. Any employee who is retired, as provided in this 2 act, shall be allowed such amount as the Governor and
- 3 Council shall determine not to exceed one-half the average
- 3 Council shall determine not to exceed one-half the average
- 4 wage or salary he was receiving for the five years previ-
- 5 ous to time of his retirement.
