STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

RESOLVE, Making an appropriation for the Maine Seed

Improvement Association.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the 2 sum of one thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred 3 nineteen, and the sum of one thousand dollars for the year 4 nineteen hundred twenty, to be paid to the Maine Seed Improvement Association; this amount to be used by said association for the purpose of promoting seed and crop improvement in the state of Maine, by holding an annual exhibition 8 and meeting, at which premiums shall be paid upon seed, 9 agricultural crops and products, and for the holding of field 10 meetings, and for such other purposes as may be considerable

11 advisable and profitable by the executive committee of the
12 association, and for the payment of all expenses incurred
13 in carrying out the purpose of this resolve. An itemized
14 account of all money expended shall be rendered each year to
15 the commissioner of agriculture and upon his approval and
16 presentation of proper vouchers said appropriation shall be
17 paid.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This appropriation is to be used by the Maine Seed Improvement Association to pay premiums and necessary incidental expenses at their annual exhibition which is held in the month of November. This resolve, a copy of the resolve passed in 1917 and the amount of money provided for is the same.
