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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND  
NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

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RESOLVE, Providing for the Completion of the Book of Plans of Waldo County and Appropriating Money Therefor.

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Resolved: That the state land agent be, and hereby is,  
2 instructed to cause the book of plans of Waldo county to  
3 be completed by adding to the plans already in said book  
4 such plans in the Massachusetts archives as have not al-  
5 ready been copied, and by having all copies certified by  
6 the secretary of state for Massachusetts, after which said  
7 book shall be forwarded to the register of deeds for said  
8 county of Waldo, and the sum of two hundred and fifty dol-  
9 lars, or such part of that sum as may be necessary, hereby is  
10 appropriated to pay the expense of such completion.



#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

The Seventy-eighth Legislature passed the Resolve appropriating \$250.00 to complete the plans of Waldo County. Mr. John H. Burleigh of Waterville was employed by this department for this work and on account of sickness was unable to attend to it.
