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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND  
NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

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AN ACT to Prohibit Still or Plug Fishing in All Lakes and  
Ponds in the State of Maine Which Are Inhabited by or  
Have Been Stocked with Trout, Landlocked Salmon or  
Togue.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

No person shall fish for, take, catch or kill any trout or  
2 landlocked salmon or togue at any time in any lake or pond  
3 in the state of Maine which is inhabited by or has been  
4 stocked with trout, or landlocked salmon or togue, by still  
5 or plug fishing so called.

Whoever violates the provisions of this act shall be pun-  
2 ished as provided in section twenty-one of chapter two hun-  
3 dred and nineteen of the public laws of 1917.
