STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT to Amend Chapter Three Hundred Fifty-eight of
Private and Special Laws of Eighteen Hundred Sixty-seven
Entitled "An Act to Incorporate the Great Works Log Driv-
ing Company" as Amended by Chapter Four Hundred Sixty-
six of the Private and Special Laws of Eighteen Hundred
Sixty-eight.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section four of chapter three hundred and fifty-eight of
2 the private and special laws of eighteen hundred sixty-
3 seven is hereby amended by striking out the word "fifty"
4 in the first line and inserting in place thereof the words
5 'seventy-five' and by striking out the word "twenty" in

6 the sixth line and inserting in place thereof the word
7 'thirty' and by striking out all of said section after the
8 word "tolls" in the eighth line and inserting in place there-
9 of the following: 'and said lien may be enforced in the
10 manner provided by law for the enforcement of liens on
11 logs and lumber' so that said section as amended shall read
12 as follows:

'Section 1. The company may demand and receive a toll
2 of seventy-five cents on each thousand feet board measure
3 at the wood scale on all logs or lumber which may be
4 driven down said stream from above the falls of said
5 stream at Shepley Mills in Bradley and for all logs or
6 lumber driven from below the said falls at Shepley Mills,
7 the toll of thirty cents on each thousand feet, board meas-
8 ure, at the wood scale, and shall have a lien upon all said
9 logs or lumber for the payment of the tolls, and said lien
10 may be enforced in the manner provided by law for the
11 enforcement of liens on logs and lumber.'
