STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT to Amend Section Sixty-seven of Chapter Thirty-three of the Revised Statutes, as Amended by Chapters Two Hundred Nineteen and Two Hundred Forty-four of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred Seventeen, Relating to the Licensing of Taxidermists.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section sixty-seven of chapter thirty-three of the revised
2 statutes as amended by chapters two hundred nineteen and
3 two hundred forty-four of the public laws of nineteen hun-
4 dred seventeen, is hereby amended by striking out all of
5 said section and by substituting therefor the following sec-
6 tion:

'Sect. 67. The commissioner of inland fisheries and game
2 may, in his discretion, upon application, issue a license to
3 any bona fide resident of the state of Maine as a tax-
4 idermist, who, in his judgment, is skilled in that art, of
5 good reputation and friendly to the inland fish and game
6 laws of the state; resident citizens shall pay an annual fee
7 of five dollars and unnaturalized, foreign born residents
8 shall pay an annual fee of twenty-five dollars, for such
9 license; taxidermists licensed as aforesaid may at all times
10 have in their possession, at their places of business, fish
11 and game lawfully caught or killed in open time, for the
12 sole purpose of preparing and mounting the same; and
13 such fish and game, or parts thereof, may be transported
14 to such licensee and retained by him for the purposes afore-
15 said, under such rules, restrictions and limitations as shall,
16 from time to time, be made by said commissioner. Such
17 licenses may be revoked by said commissioner, at any time
18 after notice and an opportunity for a hearing; each person
19 so licensed shall, on or before the twentieth day of Decem-
20 ber of each year, make a detailed report to said commis-
21 sioner of all they have done during the year by virtue of
22 such license; every licensee or common carrier violating
23 any provision of this chapter, or any of the rules, restric-
24 tions, or limitations made by said commissioner in accord-
25 ance with the provisions of this section, shall pay a fine of
26 not less than twenty, nor more than fifty dollars and costs
27 for each offense.'
