STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

RESOLVE, In favor of the Penobscot Tribe of Indians for the General Care, Maintenance, Relief and Education Thereof.

Resolved: Whereas, the State of Maine holds in trust for 2 the Penobscot Tribe of Indians a certain large sum of money 3 to wit; eighty-eight thousand ninety-two dollars and fifty 4 cents, and whereas all the funds appropriated by the seventy-5 eighth legislature for the care, maintenance and relief of 6 said tribe have been expended for the purposes and in the 7 manner prescribed by law, and because of the lack of avail-8 able funds said tribe may fall into distress and be deprived of 9 proper food, shelter and clothing, and whereas, by reason of 10 the foregoing facts the appropriation called for by this 11 resolve is immediately necessary for the preservation of the

12 public peace, health and safety and in the opinion of this
13 legislature constitutes an emergency as contemplated by the
14 constitution, be it therefore

Resolved, That there be paid from the state treasury to be 2 expended under the direction of the governor and council 3 by the agent of the Penobscot Tribe of Indians, for the 4 benefit of said tribe for the years nineteen hundred and 5 nineteen and nineteen hundred and twenty as follows:
