STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT to Amend Section Twenty-nine of Chapter Ninety-six of the Revised Statutes Relating to Liens on Buildings and Wharves.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section twenty-nine of chapter ninety-six of the revised
2 statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto the following
3 paragraph:

‘Whoever furnishes materials to a subcontractor, of any
2 degree, to be used by such subcontractor for any of the
3 purposes hereinbefore set forth in this section, and said
4 materials are so used, shall have a lien therefor, to the same
5 extent that an original contractor would have, and to be

6 enforced in the same manner, provided he shall have given
7 to the party to be affected by said lien written notice of his
8 intention to claim a lien on the property, at least five days
9 before he furnishes said materials. Said party to be affected
10 by said lien may prevent such lien by giving to said material
11 man, after the receipt of such notice, a notice that he will
12 not be responsible for any material furnished the sub-
13 contractor by the said material man.'
