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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND  
NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

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AN ACT to Extend the Charter of the Livermore and Augusta  
Railway Company.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the Liver-  
2 more and Augusta Railway Company, which were granted  
3 by chapter one hundred eighty-nine of the private and  
4 special laws of nineteen hundred thirteen, are hereby ex-  
5 tended for two years additional; and the persons named in  
6 said act and their associates and successors shall have the  
7 rights, powers and privileges that were granted to them  
8 by said act, to be exercised by them for the same purpose  
9 as specified in said act.

Sect. 2. Nothing herein contained is intended to repeal  
2 or shall be construed as repealing the whole or any part  
3 of any existing statute, and all the rights and duties herein  
4 mentioned shall be exercised and performed in accordance  
5 with all the applicable provisions of chapter fifty-five of  
6 the revised statutes, and acts amendatory thereof or addi-  
7 tional thereto.
