NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

RESOLVE, in favor of Rena Cooley.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the
2 sum of one hundred dollars (\$100) for the year nineteen
3 hundred and nineteen and the sum of one hundred dollars
4 for the year nineteen hundred twenty, to be paid in quarterly
5 payments of twenty-five dollars each, during each of said
6 years, to Rena Cooley of Augusta, for and in behalf of her-
7 self and her minor children, Violet and Evelyn, under the
8 supervision of the governor and council.
