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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND  
NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

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AN ACT to Amend Section Seventeen of Chapter One Hun-  
dred Twenty-seven of the Revised Statutes, Relating to the  
Manufacture of Intoxicating Liquor.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 17 of chapter 127 of the Revised Statutes is here-  
2 by amended by striking out the words "for sale" in the  
3 second line of said section, and by striking out the words,  
4 "except cider" in the third line of said section, so that said  
5 section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 17. Whoever manufactures any intoxicating liquor,  
2 except cider, and whoever sells any intoxicating liquor man-  
3 ufactured by him in this state, shall be imprisoned two  
4 months and fined one thousand dollars.'
